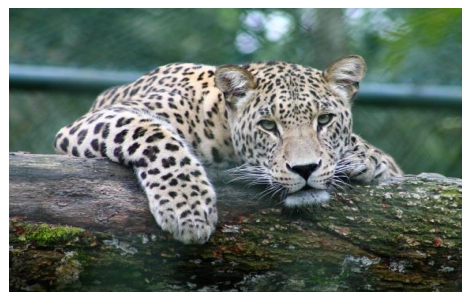
Drive in safari Dar - Mikumi -Ruaha -Udzungwa -Selous - Dar 11days /10 nights

Day I: MIKUMI NATIONAL PARK

Pick from Hotel/airport and depart to Mikumi National Park, hot lunch along the way, afternoon game drive, Dinner and overnight at Vuma Hill Camp.

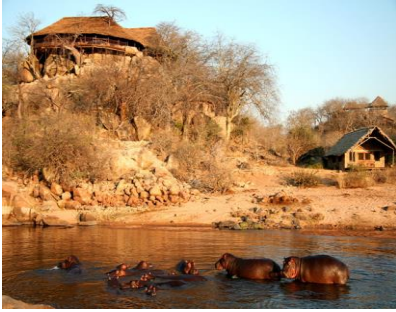


Mikumi National Park is the fourth Largest National Park in Tanzania, with abundance of wildlife situated on the southern Circuit, west of Dar es Salaam, north of Selous, past Morogoro transected by the main road easily accessible from Dar es Salaam to Iringa. Is an ideal wilderness destination for a short safari for those who do not have much time or combining with other nearby parks for unforgettable walk on the wild. More than 400 bird species have been recorded, with such colourful common residents as the lilac-breasted roller, yellow-throated longclaw and bateleur eagle joined by a host of European migrants during the rainy season. Hippos are the star attraction of the pair of pools situated 5km north of the main entrance gate, supported by an ever-changing cast of waterbirds.



Day 2: RUAHA NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast depart to Ruaha National park, hot lunch in Iringa, proceed to Ruaha and check in at Ruaha River Lodge for dinner and overnight.



Day 3/4: RUAHA NATIONAL PARK

Two full days game drives in Ruaha National park with picnic lunches. Dinner and overnight at Ruaha River Lodge.

Ruaha National Park, covering a conservation area of 10,300 square km in the south-west of the country, Ruaha National Park sprawls within and along the Great Rift Valley, covering a unique transition zone where the eastern and southern species of both fauna and flora meet against a dramatic topographical backdrop. This is also one of the few Tanzanian parks where sightings of the rarer antelopes, such as the Sable, the Roan and both lesser & Greater Kudu, are a probability rather than a possibility. The proliferation of plains game in the park also ensures that the larger predators - leopard and large prides of lion - are unusually active. The bird life, too, is unparalleled with some 530 species recorded.



Day 5: IRINGA TOWN

Bush breakfast in the park. After breakfast proceed to Iringa, visit **Isimila** (visit of stone age site and museum) and check/in at **Neema Crafts**, Afternoon sightseeing in Iringa town, church and visit market, dinner at **Saivilla**.



Day 6: UDZUNGWA HIKING MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast proceed to Udzungwa Mountains National Park. Hot lunch at Kitonga (local restaurant). Dinner and overnight at Udzungwa Forest Lodge.



Day 7: UZUNGWWA HIKING MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast full day hiking. All meals and overnight at Udzungwa Forest Lodge.

Udzungwa Mountains National Park is a forested area that is home to several species of primates, including the rare Iringa red colobus and the Sange crested mangabey monkey. Fragments of the Eastern Arc Mountains rise from the Udzungwa rainforest below and views from the peaks allow climbers to see the Selous Game Reserve and the coast of the Indian Ocean. There are many hiking trails in Udzungwa Mountains National Park that wind through various sections of the park. The most popular route is the half-day ramble to Sanje Waterfall. Mountain climbing is a popular activity that draws many visitors. Climbers can follow the trail up to Mwanihana Peak, the second highest point in the park or Luhombero Peak, the most challenging trail.



Day 8: SELOUS GAME RESERVE

After breakfast depart to Selous Game Reserve with picnic lunches. Game en-route, check in at Selous River Camp for dinner and overnight.



Day 9: SELOUS GAME RESERVE

After breakfast, set for a full day game drives in the reserve with picnic lunches. Dinner and overnight at Selous River Camp.

Selous Game Reserve (Nyerere National Park) is now the Largest National Park in Africa after been converted in 2019 from formerly popular Selous Game Reserve. The park was named in honor of the Late Mwalimu Julius Kambarage Nyerere, who was the founder of the nation. Covering an area of over 30,000 square kilometers allocated on the southern of Tanzania near Dar es salaam. One of the un crowded, undisturbed wilderness, ecological nature. Inspiring lots of tourists due to its diverse range of wildlife with significant predators and preys relationship. The might Rufiji with its renowned population of hippo and Rhino flows to Indian Ocean. The river has been designated as a photographic zone and is a popular tourist destination for boat safari, game drives, walking safaris, relaxing in the really wilderness. The sheer volume of game in the park is just outstanding. Elephant, buffalo and lion are found in greater numbers; together with the remaining part of Selous has the last true stronghold for African wild dog. Safari to this park guarantee a stunning and amazing authentic experience of a life time.



Day 10: SELOUS GAME RESERVE

After breakfast, half day game drive in the Reserve, return for lunch, awaiting evening boat safari return during sunset. Dinner and overnight at Selous River Camp

Day 11: DAR ES SALAAM

Early morning walking safari with game rangers, return for breakfast, drive back to Dar drop off at you convenience location.
