DAY 1: ARRIVAL /NAIROBI

JAMBO! Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you will be met by our Africa Customer Care Representative who will assist you with the transfer to your hotel. Before checking in at hotel, he will brief you on your program ahead and introduce the driver guide who will take you to Kenya and Tanzania safari before proceeding to Vic falls. Dinner and overnight at Ibis Style Hotel booked on Bed and breakfast.



DAY 2: NAIROBI - LAKE NAIVASHA (DRIVE)

After breakfast, you will drive to Lake Naivasha, located north-west of Nairobi. En route, you will stop at the viewpoint to enjoy the beautiful views of the Great Rift Valley escarpment. Lake Naivasha is a beautiful freshwater lake in Kenya. You will arrive just in time for lunch after which you will enjoy a unique experience on a boat safari on the lake. The waters of the lake draw a great range of game to these shores. Giraffes wander among the acacia, buffalos wallow in the swamps, and colobus monkeys call from the treetops, while the lake's large hippo population sleeps the day out in the shallows.

Accommodation: Kongoni Lodge. Meals plan: breakfast, lunch, and dinner



DAY 3: LAKE NAIVASHA – LAKE NAKURU

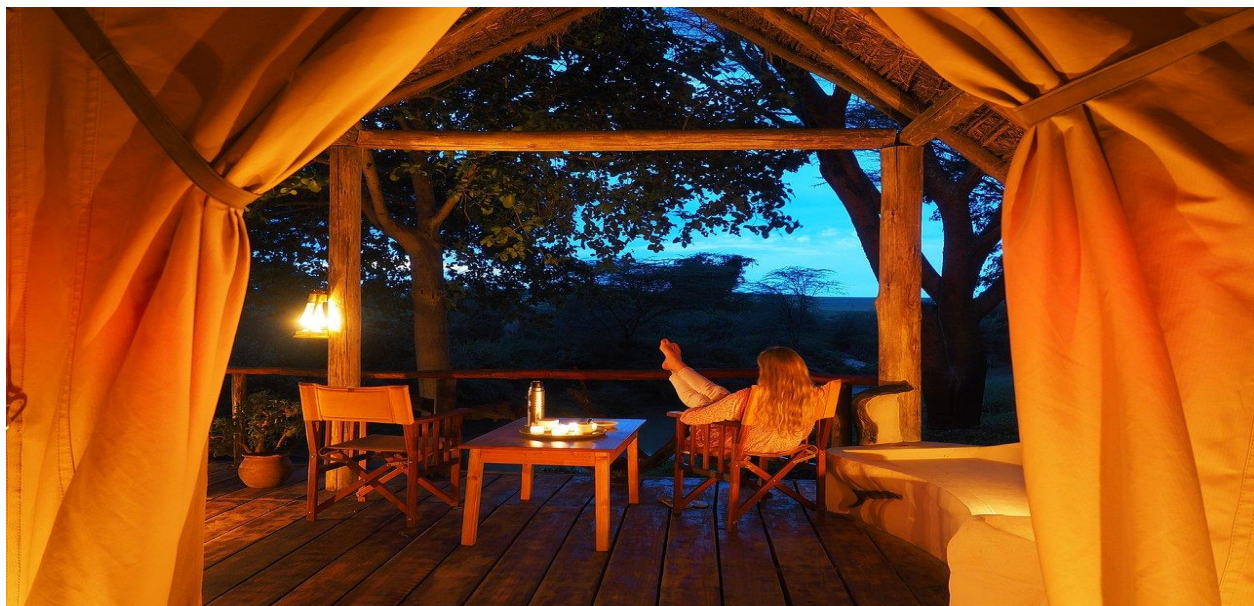
Pick from airport and drive to the floor of the Rift Valley. A stop at the Great Rift Valley view point after which continue to Lake Nakuru National Park. Start safari game drive as you drive towards the lodge. Arrive for dinner and overnight. Besides the flamingos that the lake is famous for, there are approx. 400 other species of birds visiting the lake. Also, many species of game can be found in the park including the introduced Rothschild's giraffe, black and white rhino, water buck, lion, buffalo, leopard, baboon and many species of plains game.

- Dinner and overnight at-Sarova Woodlands Lodge view the lodge
- Meal Plan: L & D
- Approximate Transit Time: 3 Hour drive



DAY 4: LAKE NAKURU - MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

This morning after breakfast you will be met by your driver guide. Your journey in our comfortable 4 x 4 Safari Van takes you to the world-famous Masai Mara National Reserve, backdrop to 'the greatest wildlife spectacle on earth', the annual migration of over one million wildebeest. Enjoy a game viewing en route to your camp followed by lunch and check in at your camp. Spend the afternoon on safari in Kenya's most popular reserve. Arrive back in camp in time for campfire cocktails dinner and overnight at Mara Base Camp Luxury Camp.



DAY 5: MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Your day will be spent on safari in Africa's richest wildlife viewing arena. Historically teeming with wildlife, the Mara hosts Kenya's largest lion prides and elephant herds. Other predators include leopard, cheetah and spotted hyena; while in the Mara River you will see fat pods of hippo and vast Nile crocodiles.

Other highlights include giraffe tops, gazelle, zebra, buffalo and over 550 species of birds.

Take the opportunity to fly over the Mara in a Hot air Balloon at an extra cost. The balloon package includes a champagne breakfast in the wild! If you can spare the money, viewing abundant game afloat a balloon is an unforgettable experience. Alternatively visit a Masai village and get learn the Masai culture at an extra cost. Dinner and overnight at Mara Base Camp Luxury Camp.



DAY 6: MASAI MARA -ISEBABIA BORDER- SERENGETI

Early morning, after breakfast, check out with packed lunches and drive to the border-cross the border and then continue by road Serengeti. Arrive and packed lunches and start safari game drive in the park.

The Serengeti is one of the most famous parks in Africa and is synonymous with wildlife and classic African scenery. It is Tanzania's oldest park and a Unesco World Heritage Site. It is home to the spectacular wildebeest migration and offers top-class wildlife viewing throughout the year.

DAY 7: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Day spent viewing game in the vast Serengeti plains morning and afternoon game drives are offered. Serengeti is easily Tanzania's most famous national park, and it's also the largest, at 14,763 square kilometers of protected area that borders Kenya's Masai Mara Game Park It is the Migration for which Serengeti is perhaps most famous.

Over a million wildebeest and about 200,000 zebras flow south from the northern hills to the southern plains for the short rains every October and November, and then swirl west and north after the long rains in April, May and June. So strong is the ancient instinct to move that no drought, gorge or crocodile infested river can hold them back. The Wildebeest travel through a variety of parks, reserves and protected areas and through a variety of habitat. Join us to explore the different forms of vegetation and landscapes of the Serengeti ecosystem and meet some of their most fascinating inhabitants

DAY 8: SERENGETI - NGORONGORO

After breakfast, checkout and drive to Ngorongoro with packed lunches -arrive and descent to the crater with picnic lunches until early evening. Dinner and overnight at the Lodge

- Main destination: Ngorongoro National Park.
- Accommodation: Ngorongoro Octagon lodge or similar standard.
- Meals & drinks: Breakfast, Lunch and dinner + plenty of drinking water while you are in the park
- Meal Plan: B, L & D
- Approximate Transit Time: 3 Hour drive

DAY 9: NGORONGORO - TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK.

Pick up at 6:30 AM and depart for Tarangire National Park with a picnic lunch for a full day game drive. Tanzania's third largest National park is known for its majestic baobab trees that dot the landscape, dwarfing the animals that feed beneath them. The Tarangire River is the centerpiece of this park which is famous for some of the largest herds of elephants in Africa. Here you may see lion, leopard, cheetah, lesser kudu, buffalo, Oryx, eland, giraffe and zebra. After game drive, you will drive to Arusha for your overnight stay booked on dinner and breakfast.



DAY 10: ARUSHA - AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK (DRIVE) (KENYA)

You will continue your journey today to Arusha. At Arusha, which is the exact center between Cape Town and Cairo, you will stop for lunch. You will then cross the Namanga border between Tanzania and Kenya and drive to Amboseli National Park, situated at the foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro, the tallest mountain in Africa. After another exciting game drive, you will check in to your lodge for the night.

- Accommodation: Kibo Luxury Safari Camp.
- Meals plan: breakfast, lunch, and dinner



DAY 11: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK - NAIROBI (DRIVE)

After breakfast at your lodge, you will have your last game experience in Kenya, seeing herds of elephants, and enjoying taking photos, as Amboseli is an amazing park for photography. Following lunch at the lodge, you will bid farewell to the game experience and are transferred to your hotel near the airport in Nairobi.

- Accommodation: Ibis Style Hotel, Nairobi
- Meals plan: breakfast and lunch

DAY 12: NAIROBI - VICTORIA FALLS (FLIGHT ZAMBIA)

You will be transferred to the airport for your flight from Nairobi to Victoria Falls. Pick up at the airport check in at the hotel Freshen up while waiting for pick up for sunset cruise.



- Accommodation: Ilala Lodge Hotel / the Kingdom Hotel, Victoria Falls
- Meals plan: Full board.

DAY 13: VICTORIA FALLS

Pick up after breakfast for guided tour of the falls it can take plus or minus 2& half hours. From tour of the falls they will go to helicopter flight over the falls. From helicopter flight they will go to big tree tour en route to vulture feeding at 1 pm Lunch at look out cafe after lunch we go to village tour we they will meet the locals at country side From village tour back to the hotel waiting for pick up for Boma dinner Pick up at 7 for Boma dinner. Boma dinner is more than dinner but entertainment center Drop off at the hotel after dinner.

- Meals plan: breakfast and snacks



DAY 14: DEPART VICTORIA FALLS

Your incredible game safari has come to an end and you will be transferred to the airport for your departure flight.

The cost for the two adults per person sharing will be US \$ 5455

And the cost for the two children per person will be US \$ 4885
